October 2018 India Missions Trip

This year we took our first team of 5 people to West Bengal to see the village anxiously awaiting the completion of our 2nd school! We weren't sure what God had in store for us but we brought multiple suitcases full of supplies, which came in handy as we ended up organizing a 2-day Vacation Bible School for around 70 kids. We also spent a day meeting with the villagers, to include the Hindu neighborhood with dozens of children waiting for our school to open,

Several of the children we worked with were from the Tea Garden, a poverty-stricken community of tea workers paid an average of \$1 a day when work can be found. The girls in this neighborhood are often forced into the sex-trade upon becoming teenagers. It is our goal to get the school open for March 2019 classes and house the tea garden children away from existing dangers in their community.



Current Needs

\$14,000 needed to finish the first level of the school and start classes in March 2019

\$23,000 needed to complete the second level of the school

\$16,000 needed for a potential children's home for Tea Garden children
