Our Trip to India

In February, we made a trip to India to visit the Blessings Academy in Yeasom Village, Manipur. Although we had seen pictures of the site, nothing could prepare us for that first glimpse of the school's strong brick structure standing amongst village buildings made of bamboo and pieces of tin. The school rests on the side of a hill in between valleys and hills harboring rice paddy fields and roaming cattle. Yeasom Village is home to about 100 adults and 70 children. Several identical villages are interspersed within a 10 mile radius, but there is one huge difference between those villages and Yeasom...they don't have a school.

67 children from ages 5 to 12 are currently attending the Blessings Academy and at least 30 more from surrounding villages are on a waiting list. The school can't accept any more students at this time because there is nowhere to house them until the children's home is finished. All funds have been raised for the home, the ground has been leveled, and materials have been purchased. The construction is on schedule to be completed for the start of the Fall 2012 term. The first phase of the children's home will be able to hold 100 students, but we anticipate this number will be reached quickly and a second story will need to be added to the children's home in the near future.
